BOW HUNTING INFORMATION

Bow hunting Africa's dangerous game has a number of restrictions pertaining to draw weight, arrow weight and the best type of broad head to use. The following dangerous game may not be hunted with a bow and arrow in South Africa:

Elephant, Leopard, Black & White Rhino

THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM WEIGHTS ARE REQUIRED:

	DRAW WEIGHTS	ARROW WEIGHTS
Small game (up to Blesbuck) Medium game (up to Eland)	60 Pounds	400g
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Giraffe• Predators• Bush pig• Warthog• Crocodile• Baboon	70 Pounds	550g
Big game (Buffalo and Lion)	80 Pounds	750g

The guide is based on the following:

- The body mass of the animal
- The arrow having a minimum mass of 7,5 grains / 1b draw weight
- A minimum two bladed, steel cutting edged broad head of minimum 28 mm width (1,1").

Hunting is done from blinds / hides (ground blinds and elevated blinds), we also do spot and stalk for the more experience hunter. We also have the best skinners to prepare your trophies making sure that your memories of the hunt are enhanced and never forgotten.

Safaris vary from 7 – 21 days.
